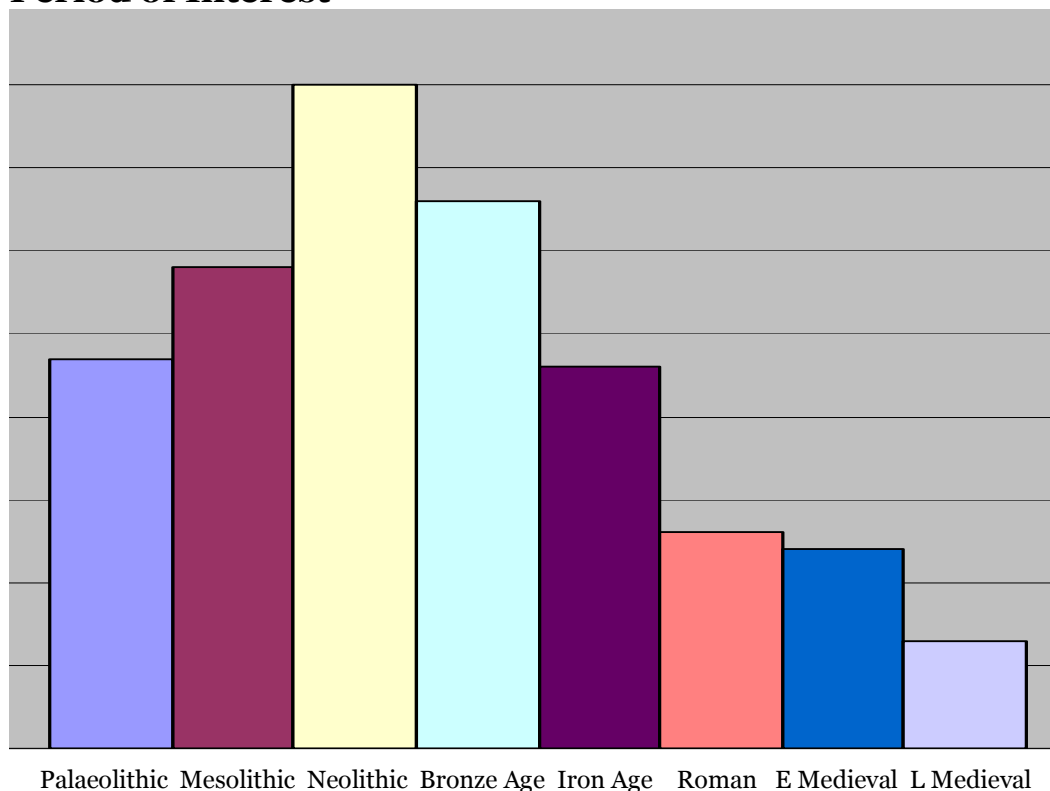
Sites

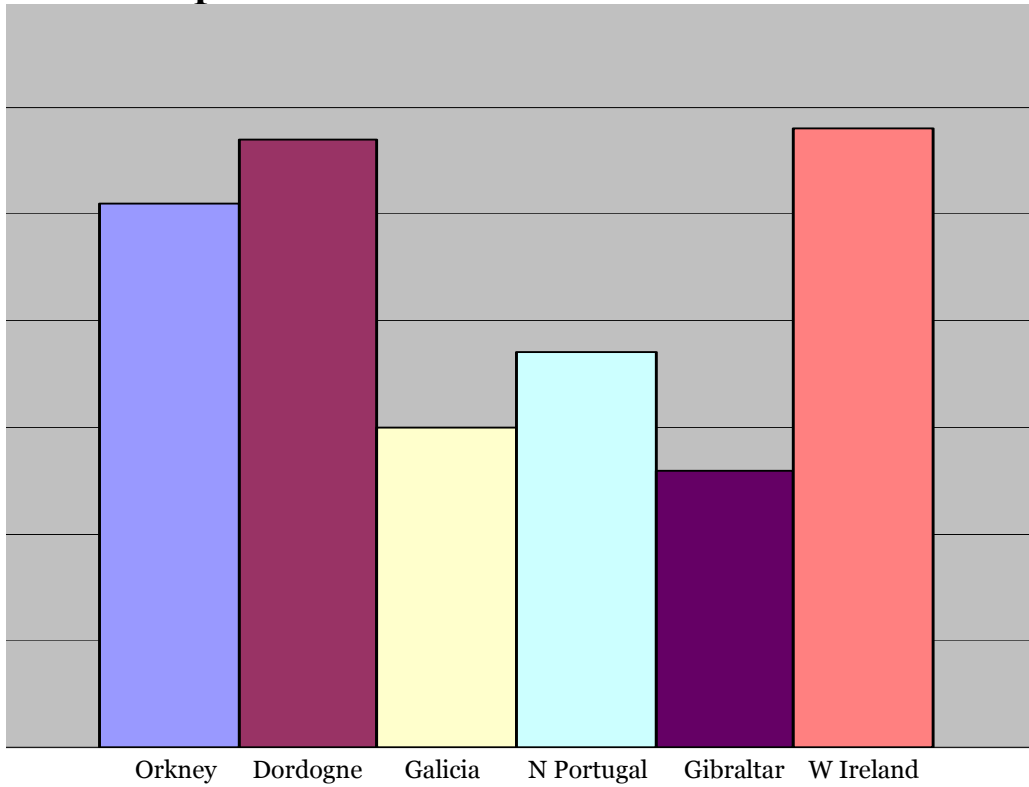
Accommodation & Travel
