The last 15 years have seen a massive increase in offshore development around the UK which has provided archaeologists the opportunity to find and examine new sites from areas of seafloor, in deeper waters and further from the coastline than was previously possible. The interpretation of geophysical and geotechnical data has significantly advanced our understanding of the preservation of inundated palaeolandscapes over large areas, and the potential for archaeological sites to be found and investigated within these landscapes. This presentation will provide an overview to the study of submerged palaeolandscapes, the methodologies used and a case study of the Early Middle Palaeolithic site Area 240 site
